SHORT DESCRIPTION	<p>The ICOMs is a framework designed to stimulate the integration of international and intercultural competencies into curricula. It defined 'international competences' in the typical context of higher education and developed a set of international competences. There are 5 fields or clouds of international competences:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Personal Growth 2. Intercultural Competence 3. Language Skills 4. Global Engagement 5. International Disciplinary Learning
GOALS (why do we use it?)	This model of international competences is the framework of a learning outcome assessment of students at the one hand and an examination of the integration of international learning outcomes in curricula of different training programs (including teacher training) at the other hand.
