The 5th European Congress of the ER-WCPT will be held on the 11 and 12 September 2020 in Leuven, Belgium in collaboration with ENPHE. The theme of this Congress is Physiotherapy Education and the three tracks linked to this are:

Submission process:

All submissions will only be accepted electronically via an on-line Abstract Submission Platform. - Abstracts are to be written in English.
- The abstract title is limited to 20 words and the abstract text is limited to 350 words. Abstracts need to report on following information: background, methods, results, discussion (including limitations) and a conclusion section.
- You will be asked to select the track from the list that best meets the described criteria. This shall enable the review process and the creation of the conference program itself.
- Please enter at least 1 and up to 3 keywords in the dedicated field.
- Reference to ethics approval will be necessary for those studies requiring such
